Draft PY 2020 Budget

A draft budget was presented to the Committee, as well as the PY 2020 budget as a comparison. The PY 2021 budget discussion began with a look at the PY21 allocations and reductions and compared to the lower carry-over amounts from PY19. The committee discussed overhead and other cost reductions at the board and service provider levels implemented to keep participant services in line with last year. It was pointed out that the budget was crafted around 30% carryover for all three fund streams, as the area is working to meet the state policy of 70% FUR. Based on the presentation information, and the discussion, Ms. Austin made the following motion:

MOTION: Approve and adopt the PY21 draft budget as presented.

Ms. Scully seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

FUR Review and Discussion

Following the PY21 Budget discussion, Mr. White presented the May FSR expenditure rate, and a projection for June based on available information. It appears that Adult and DW FUR will end at 70% based on the projections and the accrual reporting of IWT (DW funded) activities. Utilizing the earmark (or reversing earmarked funds) should allow for meeting the performance at the end of the Program Year. The Youth projection has the area missing the 70% rate by about \$128,000. The committee reviewed the projections, and then impacts of funding level reallocations at \$130,000, \$150,000, \$175,000, and \$200,000. After discussion, the committee agreed that the \$175,000 with a potential final FUR of 72.8% fit the Midlands' needs. The committee then discussed the prior reallocations and Local Areas with the capacity to received funds. Mr. Prigge made the following motions:

MOTION: Reallocate \$175,000 of Youth Funding to (1) Pee Dee and (2) Santee-Lynches WDAs. Staff should also monitor the Adult and DW expense information to ensure that a 70% FUR is achieved, including reversing funds needed from the DW to Adult Earmark.

Ms. Scully seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

Business Services Lead renewal

Annually, the Board designates a Midlands Business Services single point of contact. For the last several years, that person has been Steve Knight, staff to the MWDB. The group discussed the need to do complete this action annually. Following the discussion, Ms. Austin made a motion:

MOTION: *Maintain the appropriate MWDB staff as the Single Point of Contact for the Midlands Area Business Services Team until or if a change by the MWDB is needed.*

Mr. Prigge seconded the motion. Hearing no further discussion, a vote was taken & the motion passed unanimously.

Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
